



I followed the ants to their hiding places. Today I still marvel at the multicolored variations of the butterfly scales, of the sky studded with millions of worlds that humanity is about to discover. But among all this beauty, there's the one which the beings around us are capable of, in their aspirations, their struggles and the qualities that they bring to bear.

My drawings, paintings, sculptures, installations have always been the continuation of my many contemplations and my explorations of the universe, nature and the human being. I am looking for traits of what brings us all together, from one end to the other of the cosmos, because I have, every moment, this intuition that we are 1, here, elsewhere, everywhere, yesterday, now, eternally .
